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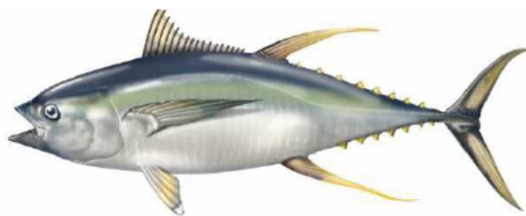

Responsible fishing or sustainable fishing / our definition



► **Responsible fishing** (BV Recognition): Obligation of means -> best practices

- at level of fishing vessel or fishing company on 4 responsibilities:
- Marine Ressources
- Environment respect
- Social practices & safety for crew
- Product quality and safety



► **Sustainable fishing (ecolabel)**: obligation of results / sustainability of a fishery

- Conservation of fish the stock + eco-system /biodiversity
- Efficient fishery management system with scientific data /regulation /control...



Responsible fishing Certification & Recognition



- **“B to C” certification schemes** (ecolabel) with visible logo on the product for consumer:

- **MSC (Marine Stewardship Council) : Fishery & CoC** (“chain of custody”)



- **FOS (Friends of the Sea): Fishery & CoC** (“chain of custody”)



- **Ecolabel Pêche durable France (2016)**



- **“B to B”** : if client doesn't find in those international ecolabel, his purposes / CSR policy
- Responsibility for marine resources, environment, crew & social, quality –food safety

BUREAU VERITAS Recognition for “responsible fishing”

Created in 2005 as private standard by BV :

Specifications on 4 Responsibilities:

- -> Food safety – sensorial quality & traceability
- -> Marine Resources –biodiversity (selectivity, min.size, bycatch..)
- -> Environment (pollution prevention, energy, CFC, CO2...)
- -> Safety of crew -workers and social best practices

•Fishing
vessels

•+ integration of processing plants for **traceability & quality**

▶ This “BV private” scheme is proposed when MSC is not accessible (on fishery level) -> BV standard is applicable on fishing company level as responsible player in a fishery which is not eligible to international CER (MSC or other)

• Possibility of annual review of the standard with **progress plan** / responsibility coverage

•Market recognition? **Mainly in France, Spain** (in developpement in Asia)

• **Existing 60 fishing vessels** (Atlantic, Indian, Pacific Ocean + Antarctic)

• **+ 6 processing plants** (France, Spain, Mauritius, Seychelles, Namibia, Argentina,)

BUREAU VERITAS Recognition for “responsible sourcing”

- ▶ This Responsible sourcing Recognition is applicable for all seafood (aquaculture & fisheries products)
- ▶ To prove by third party audit, the CSR policy and engagements are rigorously applied in the company
- ▶ Standard : close to product certification (ISO Guide 65)
 - with technical specifications (objectiv, significant, mesurable), control and records
 - Integration of the existing QMS in place for the supply-chain management
 - Definition of progres plan (short –long term) with indicators
 - Possibility of annual review of the standard

Specifications to be defined on 4 Responsibilities:

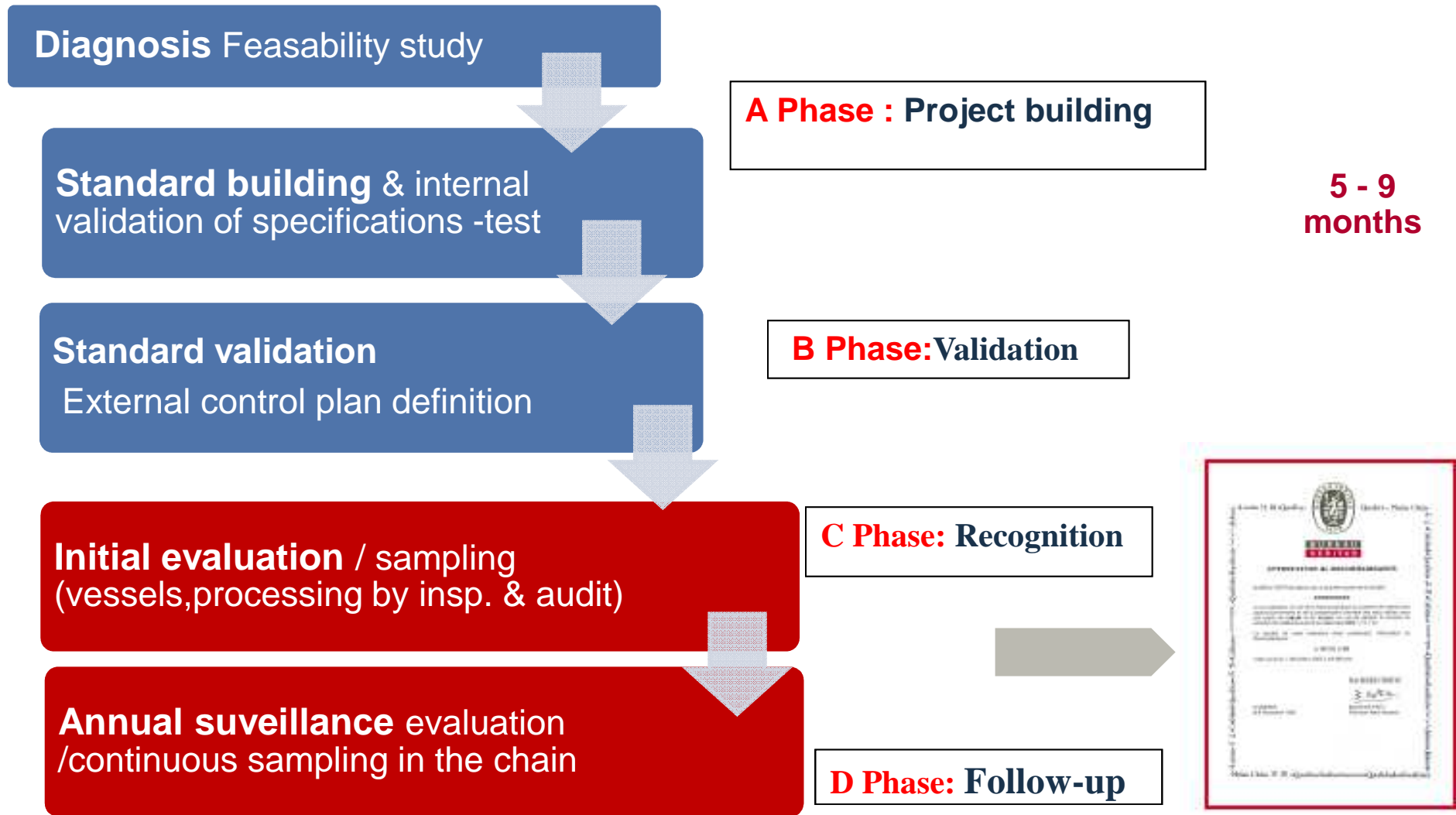
- -> Food safety – sensorial quality & traceability
- -> Responsible aquaculture product sourcing
- -> Responsible fishing product sourcing
- -> Social good practices , fair trade

•Applicable at each step of the supply-chain

Phase A :Faisability study : *Risk analysis*

- ▶ Traceability management
 - On site visite along supply-chain / traceability on fishing vessels, transshipment, in port, storage, transport, processing...
 - Identification at each step, records
 - Internal monitoring / existing external check

- ▶ Food safety & quality:
 - HACCP + best practices identification, local regulation & control

- ▶ Marine resources : targeted species, fishing gear, fishery:
 - stock status, fishery regulation, by-catches, local good practices on board

- ▶ Social accountability (ILO)
 - safety, on board, no child & forced -bounded labors, local regulation & control, life on board....
